Dear Parents and Carers,

Dentists Our Together for Children Family Support Worker has been informed that some local NHS dentists have stopped automatically sending out routine 6-monthly appointments for children on their register which may result in them being removed. She has advised that parents check in with their dental practice to ensure that the next appointments are booked in.

Year 5 and 6 parents We have received a message from Northumbria police about a WhatsApp group called 'everyone you know x'. There are currently 500 members and the group encourages members to self-harm following a social media trend. We would encourage parents and carers to regularly check their child's use of messaging apps and social media and discuss ways to ensure that they are safe online. If your child has been affected by seeing similar content online, the NSPCC website has information that you may find useful.
