**Reading Books** – Children will begin to bring home their new school reading book over the next few days. **Year 6 Parents' SATs Information Event** As stated on the key dates sent out in September and listed in the newsletter before Christmas, we have a Y6 SATs information evening on Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> January at 5pm. We want as many parents as possible to be able to attend this event so have decided to run it twice on the same day – as well as at 5pm, we will have the same event at 2:15pm. We envisage this earlier running will take us up to near the end of the school day for collection time. At this event, we will explain the itinerary for SATs week, look at some past papers and give advice to enable you to help and support your child at home. If you cannot make it along, please contact Miss Allen or Miss Walters. Both the earlier and later event will be held in the school hall – please come to the school office to sign in.
