

You can support your child by ensuring they are reading at home everyday.


Please support your child in learning their times tables.

English Basic Skills

We will learn how to use:

- Pronoun which replace nouns
- Punctuation such as inverted commas and possessive apostrophes
- Suffixes and Prefixes
- Different sentence openers

<u>Maths</u>

- Place Value recognise the place value of each digit in a threedigit number (hundreds, tens, ones)
- Adding and subtracting with 3-digit numbers
- Writing and calculating multiplications

Maths Basic Skills

- Count from 0 in multiples of 2, 5, 10, 3, 4, 8, 50 and 100.
- Find 10 or 100 more or less than a given number.
- Compare and order numbers up to 1000.
- Identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations.
- Read and write numbers up to 1000 in numerals and in words.
- Solve number problems and practical problems involving these ideas.
- Add and subtract mentally.



We will be learning about animals including humans. We will be focusing on the types of nutrients we need and what is healthy for our bodies. We will also be looking at the human skeleton.



Geography

In geography, we will be learning how to accurately use a map to locate cities in the UK. We will also be using directional language to locate the five oceans and seven continents.

History

Our history topic this term is The Tudors. We will be learning about the different monarchs. In this we will be focussing on Henry VIII and examining the impact he had on the England we know today.

RE

In RE we will be looking at what Christians believe about Jesus. We will be looking at what other names Jesus is known as and the main events in Jesus' life.

<u>PE</u>

In PE this term, we will be learning how to perform a range of dance styles including musical theatre.

<u>Art</u>

Our focus this term in art is expressionism. We will be looking at the work of Edvard Munch and be creating our own interpretations of his art.
