Over the next three weeks, please support us by using any spare time at home to test your child's times table knowledge. Firing questions at them during car rides, walking to school or even while they eat their tea can really improve their speed and confidence. Additionally, all children have a Times Tables Rockstars login where they can fine tune their speed and performance. If you have any questions regarding supporting your child with their times tables, please speak to Miss Lawson or Miss Hussain.
